A huge part of the Waterboyz DNA has grown out of Isaiah 58 of following God's heart to serve the oppressed, poor and forgotten. PHONE NUMBER EXCHANGE—As each meeting comes to a close every man writes his name and phone number on the memory verse for the next week. We throw this into a pile and we each select a name with a commitment to call the man we draw before the next meeting. We keep the calls brief - 2 or 3 minutes - because we are all busy. In that phone call we ask accountability questions, catch up with where the battle over ordinary vs. transformation is raging and we pray for each other. Community and accountability is created and we all begin to 'do' life together.

SERVING SATURDAY—On the third Saturday of every month we go serve someone in the community (God always shows us the next project) for a few hours. Men serve if and as they are able. We gather, read a little bit of Scripture, and then eat some donuts, drink some coffee, and become the hands and feet of Jesus to someone in need.

ANNUAL 100-MEN CHOIR & MENS ADVANCE—Once a year we have a men's choir (100MEN singing on Father's day about our intention to speak to the nations about who Jesus is), and a Men's retreat (we call it an ADVANCE) where we spend a weekend pressing hard into God's heart, mind and will.

This is our vision. There is nothing new under the sun but seeking the SON with all our heart's the awe and wonder we are experiencing you have to experience to fully understand. Come and join us!

Each of us finds ourselves trying to cover so many bases. Work demands, family demands, something is broke and needs fixing, there is the list of projects that your wife wants you to do, everybody wants more of you than there is to go around. You really mean to pursue a relationship with God, you have this nagging feeling in your soul that something huge is missing. But how in the world can you do one more thing? The rat race produces ordinary men. So how can I become a man of God? Where in the world would I find the time?

The Waterboyz for Jesus have made a discovery! If you are willing to invest 7 minutes a day, 1 hour a week, and a few hours one Saturday a month you WILL experience a radical transformation that will change everything! You will become a better husband, a better father, a more productive worker, and most importantly a difference maker and a mighty warrior in the Kingdom. The truth of each of our stories is that we always find the time to do what we really want to do, don't we? If you are serious about giving God a chance to change your life – give us four weeks – give it a try – what have you got to lose?

The Waterboyz for Jesus is an independent ministry which views every man who is bending his knee and allowing Jesus to be Lord and Savior in his life, no matter what church, denomination, or creed he might belong to, as belonging to the one true Church - PRAISE GOD! The Waterboyz are focused on helping 'ordinary' men become transformed into mighty warriors by building into them a solid foundation of biblical truth while at the same time challenging them to put this truth into action in their daily lives with their families, in their church, at their work place, and in their community.

“Who We Are & What We Do”

The starting point in our journey of transformation is the decision to risk a daily, personal relationship with Jesus Christ. The first decision we challenge each man to make each day is to decide who is going to be god in his life that day. Look at the man in the mirror and say, “There is a God and it isn't YOU!”. Once you have dethroned self and enthroned God then open His Word, the bible and spend 3 minutes reading. Make reading the **RED INK** a priority. You will find this **RED INK** in the gospels. After reading for 3 minutes spend the next 2 minutes praying. Pray about whatever you want to pray about, your day, your job, the sin in your life, whatever you need to say to God. Then take 1 minute and listen. Just sit quietly and wait. God just might have something to say to you.

Because it is so easy to slip back into 'ordinary' we make a choice to meet together on a weekly basis for one hour. We meet in public places such as restaurants because we agree with God that we are called to be salt and light in a lost and dying world. Each 10MEN Table lasts only 1 hour. It starts on time and ends on time - men don't like to be held 'hostage'. There are 10MEN Tables located all over the metropolitan area, they meet at different times, in different places, and on different days. In other words there is definitely one that will work for you no matter what your schedule looks like. (for a complete updated listing of 10MEN Table times and locations visit our website). Anyone can attend any table at any time. Many men often go to more than one table during the course of any given week.

10MEN tables are “covered” with an atmosphere of trust, vulnerability and transparency. **10MEN** tables follow a very simple interactive format as we call each other into a deeper relationship with Jesus. When the time to start arrives someone will pray the group into God's presence. After a few announcements about upcoming events we begin to **S.O.A.P** scripture.

S.O.A.P - is an acronym.

S-Scripture-Each week a chapter is selected to be read. We go around the table and read a few verses each. When a verse jumps out at you we write it down following the acronym and then (share) what we wrote.

O-Observation-Explain why this particular verse of all the verses read jumped out at you.

A-Application-How does this verse apply or will apply in my personal life.

P-Prayer-Write out a prayer to seal the commitment that God has called you to in the verse He showed you today. Pray that you will have the courage to allow this verse to become a living word in your life. That God will use this verse to cause you to decrease and Him to increase in your life.

GOD QUESTION—Each week the Table Leader prays about a question to ask that is from God, that will challenge the hearts and minds of men to grow and mature in Christ. Each man is given a minute as we go around the table to respond and share with the group.

SCRIPTURE MEMORY—Each week the men at the table are challenged to memorize the “verse of the week”. The goal is to hide 52 verses in our hearts during the year.

SCRAPS—The Waterboyz grew out of a God prompting during a weekly men's group to start a God Fund called Scraps. Scraps are simply giving up a convenience or something you enjoy for something you value more.

The challenge is to sit down with God and have a conversation about what you are going to give up as an offering to Him as an act of worship. As a place where He can be proud to be your Dad. At each meeting, your “Scraps” (the money you saved from giving up something that you donate for something of Kingdom
